



### ACCESSIBILITY

Due to the historic nature and riverside location of Buckler's Hard, some areas are less accessible to visitors with limited mobility. The site has remained almost unchanged since the 18th Century and is composed of gravel or unmade pathways, slopes which increase in gradient towards the river, natural undulations and narrow doorways.
