

Car Club Rally Charges 2024

Our standard charges for use of facilities, supply of admission tickets for access to your rally and the Buckler's Hard attractions, including the Maritime Museum, are given below.

Admission

All persons, including the organisers, attending the event must have an admission ticket. One admission ticket is given free of charge to the organiser of the rally. Tickets are valid for one day only and are supplied in advance.

Rally admission tickets admit the holder to all the Buckler's Hard attractions including the Maritime Museum, Shipwright's Cottage and St Mary's Chapel. The River Cruise is an additional charge and can be included in ticket options shown below.

^{*} Child tickets are aged 5 to 16 inclusive, all people attending the event aged 17 and over are classified as an adult. Please note, The River Cruise runs Easter to October. All participants of a booking require the same ticket type.

Arriving and departing at Buckler's Hard

We ask all organisers to pre-arrange and agree a suitable arrival time with the events team prior to your visit date. Please note, access is not permitted prior to 10am unless agreed in writing beforehand. All participants must arrive within 30 minutes of the pre-arranged arrival time otherwise, they will forfeit their right to park on the village high street and will be directed to park in the standard visitor car park, parking charges apply.

All rally participants must exit the village high street by 4pm in the summer and by 3pm in the winter, please contact the events team for exact timings depending on your visit date. The organiser will be responsible for the safe exit of all vehicles from the village high street. Further information will be provided once your booking has been confirmed.

Minimum Numbers

If the number of vehicles is likely to be less than 15, please contact the Events Department to discuss rates and location. For smaller rallies, we expect final numbers of the participants attending at least 2 weeks prior to your visit date and **payment in advance** for all participants, there will be no facility for ticket sales on arrival.

Parking

Parking for all rallies will be on the village high street as a standard however, this is subject to ground conditions. Should it be deemed that the ground conditions on the village high street are not suitable then an alternative location will be used, the coach car park will be reserved for rally parking in this instance. Please note, that the village high street can park a maximum of 75 vehicles & the coach car park can accomodate a maximum of 30 vehicles, with additional areas located in the main car park adjacent, if required.

River Cruise

The River Cruise is subject to availability and runs from Easter to October, for exact dates please contact the Events Department. Pre-booking a sail time is mandatory, as we require all participants to board the same ferry. Sail times are as follows: 11.00, 11.45, 12.45, 13.30, 14.15, 15.00, 15.45, 16.30. The River Cruise sets sail from the jetty at the bottom of the high street and it is advised that you arrive approximatley 10 minutes before the ferry sets sail. All sailings are subject to the conditions of carriage which can be found here: https://www.bucklershard.co.uk/terms-conditions/#conditions-carriage If you fail to arrive for your designated time slot, you will be unable to transfer to another sailing. No refunds will be offered. In the event of a cancellation of The River Cruise, we shall only refund you the difference.

Additional Information

Admission Times

Buckler's Hard opens to visitors at 10am and closes at 5pm March to October and 4pm October to February (times and dates subject to change). Please note, access to parking on the village high street is from 10am unless agreed in writing beforehand. All participants are required to arrive within 30 minutes of the pre-arranged arrival time.

Tickets

All ticketing will be provided by BEL. No other tickets are permitted unless discussed and agreed in writing in advance.

Entry of rally participants

BEL will facilitate the checking, collecting and sale of tickets on arrival (when applicable).

Tickets issued to the organiser in advance are the responsibility of the organiser and these must be distributed amongst all participants for ease on arrival. There will be no facility to purchase additional tickets on arrival without prior agreement. Access to the village high street will be via The Master Builders House Hotel entrance where a steward will then direct you through to the village high street. Further information will be provided once your booking has been confirmed.

Parking of rally participants

It is the responsibility of the club to provide the appropriate number of parking officials and banksman. BEL accepts no responsibility for parking procedures unless agreed in writing prior to the event. We recommend a pre-event visit to familiarise yourselves with the parking areas, paying particular attention to the uneven ground conditions at Buckler's Hard.

Catering

Individual picnics are welcome and there are onsite facilities to use as well. The Captain's Table serves cooked breakfasts, cream teas and light lunches, as well as all-day snacks and hot drinks, a menu can be found on the Buckler's Hard website. Alternatively, The Master Builder's House Hotel is availabile for a variety of meal options, more information can be found here: https://www.hillbrookehotels.co.uk/the-master-builders/eat-drink/, pre-booking is strongly advised.

Signs

BEL will provide standard signs to direct members from the main road to the appropriate event location. No other signs are permitted unless discussed and agreed in writing in advance. External road signage, where suitable, must be arranged in advance through an approved BEL contractor and costs to be covered by the organsier.

Print and Publicity

The Buckler's Hard logo can be supplied for use in your own newsletters to members provided permission is obtained in advance and our corporate identity guidelines which will be supplied are adhered to. Promotional or advertising material directed at the general public must first be submitted in draft form to BEL for approval prior to publication.

Payment

Payment should be made in advance at least 2 weeks prior to the visit date for final numbers. Tickets will be sent in advance to the organiser for distribution to all participants. This makes for a swifter and easier access on the day. No additional ticket sales will be available on the day for small rallies.

Exclusive Use

We are unable to offer exclusive use of the Buckler's Hard village and Maritime Museum.
